COUNTY ROAD PROJECT NO.: 1829-R

WHEREAS, on Mason County Road No. 41640, known locally as the Skokomish Valley Road, and more specifically located in Sec. 16, T21N, R4W, WM; , M.P. 1.70 to M.P. 1.88, work defined as "construction" in the BARS Manual, Page II-63, et seq. is determined to be necessary and proper, and,

WHEREAS, this project is identified as # 14 on the officially adopted 2011 Annual Construction Program.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS that it is their intention to:

Perform engineering and right of way for the realignment and construction of the Hunter Creek Bridge replacement.

SAID WORK is to be performed by Contract in accordance with the Washington State Standard Specifications for Road and Bridge Construction as adopted by Mason County.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the above described County Road Project is necessary and proper, and the estimated costs of said project are herewith set out as follows:

Engineering	\$ <u>336,500.</u>
Right-of-Way	\$ <u>45,000.</u>
Road Construction	\$ <u>1,874,736.</u>

The County Road Project herein described is HEREBY DECLARED to be a public necessity, and the County Road Engineer is HEREBY ORDERED AND AUTHORIZED to report and proceed thereon as by law, provided and in accordance with RCW 36.77.020 et. seq.
