

ORDINANCE NO. 64-11

SPEED LIMITS
MASON COUNTY ROADS

WHEREAS, on August 23, 2011, the Board of County Commissioners prepared and published a Notice of Hearing considering the speed limit change on a portion of Skokomish Valley Road, County Road No. 41640.

WHEREAS, as authorized by RCW 46.61.415 speed limits on County roads in Mason County, Washington, were fixed by Ordinance No. 14-81 on April 20, 1981, as 50 miles per hour, except certain roads as otherwise posted; and,

WHEREAS, said ordinance was superceded in its entirety on July 21, 1987 under Ordinance No. 55-87; and,


WHEREAS, existing condition on the following road in Mason County warrants a speed limit change, as shown:

41640	Skokomish Valley Road	45	40	1.509 - 2.196 (Portion)

THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED AND ORDERED, that the speed limit is effective immediately as shown on the above listed county road, and the County Engineer is so directed to erect the necessary speed limit signs in conformity herewith.
