### **CALL FOR BIDS**

**Bid Title: Ground Preparation, Pad Installation, and Playground Equipment Installation.**



Notice is hereby given that Mason County Parks & Trails Department will receive sealed bids for the installation of playground equipment at Mason County Sandhill Park, 1000 North East Sandhill Road, Belfair, Washington. 98528.

**SCOPE OF WORK:** Playworld, Challenger 350-2179, Ages 5-12, Space Required 35'1" x 40' 0". Complies with ASTM F1487, CPSC Pub.325 (Public Playground Safety Handbook).

This project consists of furnishing all labor, materials, and equipment necessary for the site preparations for the installation of the Playworld, Challenger 350-2179 playground equipment, installation of the equipment itself, and the installation of Greatmats play time playground green 1 ¼ inch turf with 2-inch pad per square foot or a like product, that is commercial quality design and interlocking design. The padding provides commercial safety level protection for playground outdoor ground fall hazards complying with ASTM fall height tested approved by Occupational Safety and Health Administration (OSHA) and Washington Industrial Safety and Health Act (WISHA).

**Location:** The project's location is Sandhill County Park, 1000 NE Sand Hill Road, Belfair, Washington, 98528. The actual location of the playground equipment at the Sandhill County Park will be marked off by Mason County Park Staff and work coordinated with the contact person.

**Compliance**

The Contractor(s) shall observe and comply with all applicable laws, ordinances, and the rules and regulations of all authorities having jurisdiction over the County's contract. The Contractor(s) shall comply, when applicable, with the U. S. Department of Labor, Safety and Health Regulations identified as Chapter XVII of Title 29, Code of Federal Regulations (CFR) Parts 1910 and 1926 and subsequent amendments. The Contractor(s) shall meet or exceed all County, State, Federal safety guidelines and standards. All OSHA applicable guidelines and standards.

The Contractor(s) agrees that in the hiring of employees for the performance of work under the County's contract or any subcontract, no contractor, subcontractor, or any person acting on their behalf shall, by reason or race, color, religion, sex, national origin, age, familial status, disability, pregnancy, sexual orientation, gender identity, or gender expression, or any prohibition provided by federal or state law, discriminate against any citizen of the State in the employment of labor or workers who are qualified and available to perform the work to which the employment relates, nor shall any contractor, subcontractor, or any person acting on their behalf, in any manner, discriminate against or intimidate any employee hired for the performance of work under the County's contract on account of race, color, religion, sex, national origin, age, familial status, disability, pregnancy, sexual orientation, gender identity, or gender expression, or any prohibition provided by federal or state law.

#### **Debarment**

Contractor certifies that to the best of its knowledge and belief they are not presently debarred, suspended, proposed for debarment, declared ineligible, or voluntarily excluded from covered transactions by any Federal department or agency.

#### **Prevailing Wage**

Contractor agrees to comply with Prevailing Wage requirements, RCW 39.12, and to file all required forms, certifications, and affidavits necessary to comply with Federal and State laws before final payment shall be made to the Contractor.

Upon request, the County will mail a hard copy of the applicable prevailing wages for this project.

#### **Insurance Requirements. All insurance provided shall be primary and non-contributory.**

- Comprehensive General Liability. \$1,000,000 combined single limit per occurrence for bodily injury, personal injury and property damage, \$2,000,000 general aggregate;
- Automobile Liability. \$1,000,000 combined single limit per accident for bodily injury and property damage;
- Workers' Compensation. Workers' compensation limits as required by the Workers' Compensation Act of Washington;
- Consultant's Errors and Omissions Liability. \$1,000,000 per occurrence and as an annual aggregate.

#### **Submittal Criteria**

All bid proposals shall include the following:

- Detailed description of proposed plan of work with timeline
- Washington State UBI No.
- Project budget breakdown including Washington State Sales Tax
- Certification of Compliance with Wage Payment statutes – Attachment A

County offices are not open for special mail or other delivery on weekends and County holidays. The County shall assume no responsibility for delay in U.S. mail service or for bids delivered to County offices other than the specified County Office. Bids received after the time stated in the bid will not be accepted and will be returned, unopened, to the Bidder. There will be no exceptions or waivers of this requirement.

Mason County reserves the right to accept or reject bids on each item separately or as a whole, to reject any or all bids, to waive informalities and to contract as to the best interest of Mason County.
